The Palace has been home to the Bishops of Bath & Wells for over 800 years (although today the Bishop lives in an apartment above his offices.)

The famous swans live in the moat and are taught to ring the bells for food! You may get your food at the Bishop's Table Café on site or lunch in the many places in the city.

You may tour the 14 acres of gardens, the chapel and the Palace at your own pace.



Wells Cathedral

At 2pm we assemble in Wells Cathedral for one of the various tours on offer.
