



We will be travelling by Upton Coaches leaving Brushford Parish Hall at 8.30am, Bampton (Brook Street) at 8.45 and the Hartnell Hotel at 8.50am and leaving Wilton at 4pm

Wilton House has been the Earl of Pembroke's ancestral home for 460 years. Inigo Jones and John Webb rebuilt the house in the Palladian style after a fire in 1647. Further alterations were made by James Wyatt in 1801. The house contains one of the finest art collections in Europe and is set in magnificent landscaped parkland.

In addition to the House and Grounds, there is a cafe, gift shop and a classic car exhibition.

Tours of the House last about 1 hour and run every half hour. They are booked at the admissions desk upon arrival.

The cost of travel and admission is £49.
